Construction Standards – Street Section


Public Works Director Boettcher presented Council with the Street Section of the Construction Standards. He reviewed with Council previous street decisions made by Council and also reviewed decisions and recommendations of the Public Works Committee.

Key points of discussion:

- Review Council's decision of two sidewalks everywhere
- Width of residential streets
- Number of homes with single point access. Up to 150 lots and up to 300 lots on an interim basis
- Cul-de-sac length limitation set at 500 ft
- Number of homes on a private street, short plats or just a number
- Street light types
- Mailboxes
