- 6. What are your suggestions regarding how best to unite our community and achieve a shared vision for the future?
- 7. How can the opinions of your constituents be incorporated in your decision making process?
- 8. Should you be confronted by an angry constituent or a Councilmember that seriously disagreed with you on an issue, how would you propose to handle such conflict?
- 9. How would you improve communication with the public and businesses?

- 10. What is your expectation regarding the time commitment that will be required of you to effectively serve on the Council? Do you have any concerns about your ability to devote the time needed?
- 11. How do you feel about the Town Hall meetings?
- 12. Finally, please make the case why we should select you as the next City Councilmember.
