- How do you educate, encourage and motivate staff and council?
- Have you seen other communities use a council liaison with staff and then report back at council workstudies?
- How does this role in here in Black Diamond compare to what you faced in the City of Sammamish?
- What is your experience with conflict resolution?
- Have you ever had to fire or reprimand an employee and what is the process?
- Communication style.
- Why do you want to come here?

Mayor Olness reported funding for this position is a reallocation of funds from a YarrowBay processing fee in conjunction with City funds. She noted the split will be 75% YarrowBay and 25% City funds.

Following discussion there was Council consensus to move forward with a special meeting next week at 4:00 p.m. on a date to be determined by the Mayor to do a budget amendment and confirmation of the position.
