Shoreline Master Program

He noted being in conversation with the project manager and as long as we are working towards adoption we are okay.

- remove yellow on that page and turn it back to an X
- page 59, item 10 C4 would like to see "when feasible" inserted between bodies
- Page 60, 1 and 2 are typos that need changed and item number three is more of a policy decision

Mayor Olness asked Council if they would like to receive public comment from Mr. Sperry, Council consensus was to allow Mr. Sperry to join the discussion.

- Change setbacks to 25'
- Page 44 change to 5-15'
- Page 5, item 1 develop a table
- Page 45 mechanism #15- change to "shall"

Natural Resources/Parks Director Nix recapped Council consensus.

Councilmember Goodwin complimented Mr. Sperry for all the hard work he has put into this document.

Mr. Sperry thanked Council for the opportunity to speak on this issue.

Mayor Olness stated the next steps would be to prepare a document with the changes for posting stating "Draft" to the website and shoot for having this on the agenda at the August 16th meeting.
