## **RESOLUTION NO. 08-489**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING THE LAKE SAWYER PARK DEVELOPMENT CONCEPT PLAN AS THE CONCEPT PLANNING DOCUMENT FOR FUTURE PARK DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, in 2005 the City acquired approximately 150 acres on Lake Sawyer to be used for park purposes; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated group of citizens and professionals worked with City of Black Diamond officials and the National Park Service's Rivers, Trails and Conservation Assistance program staff to prepare a concept plan for the development of Lake Sawyer Park; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that the City Council adopt the Lake Sawyer Park Development Concept Plan as the City's official guide for future park planning and development purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the Lake Sawyer Park Development Concept Plan and finds that it will be a valuable tool for guiding future park planning and development activities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council accepts the Lake Sawyer Park Development Concept Plan dated February 5, 2008, and adopts it as the City's official concept plan for guiding future planning and development activities for the Lake Sawyer Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council, on behalf of the Mayor, the Council, and the City, expresses its sincere appreciation to the Citizens Advisory Committee, the charette participants, and the National Park Service for the time, energy and resources that they have expended to develop the Lake Sawyer Development Concept Plan.
