DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) FOR  
THE CITY OF BLACK DIAMOND COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT**

**Date of Issuance:** March 6, 2020

**Applicant:** City of Black Diamond, Community Development Department, 24301 Roberts Drive, Black Diamond, WA 98010

**Description of Proposal:** The proposed action is the emergency amendment to the City of Black Diamond Comprehensive Plan to adopt Capital Facility Plans for the Auburn, Enumclaw, Kent and Tahoma School Districts. This action is authorized under the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 36.70A.130.2.b. **Determination of Nonsignificance:** The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposed comprehensive plan amendment does not have a probable significant adverse impact. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist.

**Comment and Appeal Period:** This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340. The lead agency will not act on this proposal for fourteen days after the date of issuance. Written comments must be received by 4:30pm, on March 23, 2020.

You may appeal this determination at the Community Development Department, 24301 Roberts Drive, Black Diamond, no later than 5:00 p.m., March 31, 2020 by completing the proper appeal form and paying the required appeal fee. You should be prepared to make specific factual objections.
