Roberts Drive Closure - Traffic Impacts

March 31, 2021 through April 30, 2021

When/Where:

Beginning March 31st, construction work along Roberts Drive between Morgan St and SR 169 requires a full-road closure for pedestrians and vehicles. This closure applies for both day and night access.

Detours:

Truck Detour Routes:

See attached "Truck Detour" map. Signage and electronic message boards will warn drivers in advance of detour route.

Vehicle Detour Routes:

See attached "Vehicle Detour" map. Signage and electronic message boards will warn drivers in advance of detour route.

Local Residents living on Roberts Drive:

See attached "Vehicle Detour" map. Local residents along Roberts Drive will still have access to their homes but not directly off of SR 169 onto Roberts Drive. Local residents must use Morgan Street or Auburn Black Diamond Road to access their home.

Driving Directions:

Drivers heading East on Auburn/Black Diamond Road:

Heading East into Black Diamond on Auburn/Black Diamond road, all trucks MUST turn left onto Lake Sawyer Road. All other vehicles are encouraged to take the Lake Sawyer detour as well. Drivers will head North on Lake Sawyer Road and after the Lake Sawyer Grocery store, turn right onto 288th St. This will take you to SR 169 where you can turn back into Black Diamond or head into Maple Valley.

Drivers heading West on Roberts:

Drivers with an intent to come off SR 169 and onto Roberts must find alternate routes if they are trying to head west to Auburn/Black Diamond Road. Drivers can follow detour along 169 that takes them to 288th or can take Jones Road onto Morgan St. Trucks can ONLY take 288th.

Increased Travel Time:

All travelers are advised to avoid this area during the Roberts Drive closure as traffic and backup is likely.

Construction Activities:

Project work includes stormwater control, demo of the existing Roberts Drive turnoff from 169 and paving a new access road with better site distance for vehicles.

Closure Period:

The City of Black Diamond understands the challenges and inconveniences that commuters, residents, businesses, bicyclists and pedestrians will experience during the closure period and asks for patience and cooperation as we work to complete this project.
